



Prioritising Investment and Reforms

One topic for 2022

- Support for policy makers, programme level collaboration between national R&I programmes
- 2 projects to be supported
- 2-3 budget per proposal
- ✓ Identification of joint priorities
- ✓ Leverage of funding
- ✓ Joint activities for cross-border innovation, including uptake of results, regulatory

 - 2 projects to be funded | 1,5 mio €
- ➤ HORIZON-WIDERA-2022-ERA-01-32: An experimentation space for the uptake and use of R&I results for EU resilience and future preparedness
 - CSA
 - 1 project to be funded | 3 mio €
- Financial support to third parties





Testing of the ERA HUB concept – pilot phase


- Build stronger knowledge ecosystems
- Collaboration platform for best practice sharing across borders, sectors and disciplines
- Duild interconnected + interoperable ecosystems in the ERA for facilitating the creation, circulation, diffusion and take-up of knowledge
- Connect national regional ecosystem actors based on geography or thematic or smart specialisation or strategic considerations (ie. value chains)

Open science indicative topics

- **HORIZON-WIDERA-2022-ERA-01-40**: Stepping-up institutional and territorial changes towards open and responsible research and innovation
 - CSA
 - 1 project to be funded | budget: 5 mio €
 - 'cascading grant: Financial support to third parties : 60 K €
- **HORIZON-WIDERA-2022-ERA-01-41**: Increasing the reproducibility of scientific results
 - RIA
 - 2 projects to be funded | budget: 2 mio €
- **HORIZON-WIDERA-2022-ERA-01-44**: Developing and piloting training on the practice of open and responsible research and innovation | CSA: 1 project: 3.5 mio €



Topic: **Acceleration Services** in support of the institutional transformation of HEIs

CSA | 1 project | 10,5 mio € | Duration: up to 5 years Expected outcomes

- Together with other individual HEIs, Alliances of universities, surrounding ecosystem actors
- > Transformation agenda
 - shared R&I strategies with other HEIs
 - Sharing capacity: infrastructure, etc (European Universities Initiative)
 - Improve attractiveness of researchers' careers (assessment and incentive regimes)
 - Collaboration with ecosystem actors
 - Mainsream digitalization, open science, gender equality plans





Topic: **Acceleration Services** in support of the institutional transformation of HEIs (cont)

Expected outcomes

- Access to mentoring/coaching service
- Develop methodologies to implement the required acceleration services
- help institutions to successfully implement a strategy and roadmap for transformation
- **)** a **monitoring mechanism** to assess progress

Topic: Developing an effective ERA talent pipeline

CSA | 2 projects | 1,5-2 mio €/proposal | Duration: up to 2 years

- Based on European Skills Competences and Occupations (ESCO) framework
- Diversification of the PHD programmes and practices (including non-academic actors)
- Mainstreaming of tenure track like systems
- > to take measures to improve flow-through of talent within academia and to and from the non-academic sector
- ▶ Establishment of a PILOT (training hubs) where non-academic actors can define the priorities of researchers' training and lifelong learning upskilling





Science communication & science education

- ➤ HORIZON-WIDERA-2022-ERA-01-60: A European competence centre for science communication
 - Type of action: CSA
 - 1 project to be funded | 3 mio €
- ▶ HORIZON-WIDERA-2022-ERA-01-70: **Open schooling** for science education and a learning continuum for all
 - Type of action: CSA
 - 3 projects to be funded | 1,5-2 mio €





- **HORIZON-WIDERA-2022-ERA-01-81**: Support to the implementation of inclusive gender equality plans
- **HORIZON-WIDERA-2022-ERA-01-80**: Living Lab for gender-responsive innovation
 - Type of action: RIA
 - 1 project to be funded | 3 mio €





Topic: Support to the implementation of inclusive Gender Equality Plans (GEPs)

- **> Budge/proposal**: 0,5-1 mio € | 4 projects to be funded
- ➤ Widening eligibility criteria: Leading university or research organisation in gender equality + at least 3 less advanced institutions in widening countries incl. WB
- > Twinning exercise in gender balance in R&I across a specific discipline
- Reduce heteregeneity of implementation of GEPs
- ▶ Enhance attractiveness and research excellence of less advanced institutions in Gender Equality









Topic: Support to the implementation of inclusive Gender Equality Plans (GEPs)

- incorporate intersectionality
- > Twinning exercise in gender balance in R&I across a specific discipline
- Methods for exchanging best practices
- > Reinforce networking in the area of gender equality
- On-site visits, physical or virtual trainings, workshops, dissemination, capacity-building activities
- Implementation of specific actions in the less advanced institutions

Ethics & Integrity:

The empirical and behavioural approach to research ethics and integrity

- **Budget**: 3 mio euro 1 proposal (CSA)
- > **Trust** in science is key for an inclusive, open and democratic society
- Several factors may lead researchers to breach research ethics and integrity standards and engage in questionable research practices (individual & institutional)
- **a literature review**, map the existing knowledge on behavioural ethics and moral psychology and identify research outcomes and research needs.
- Public consultation











Ethics & Integrity: (continued)

The empirical and behavioural approach to research ethics and integrity

- improve the understanding of researchers' behaviours and incorporate this knowledge in measures aiming at enhancing promotion of ethics and integrity principles through shared responsibility (individual and institutional)
- develop a comprehensive preventive policy and support research organizations and research funders
- Develop training courses, adoption guidelines
- Structured cooperation with the e-platforms on research integrity
- Involvement of industrial partners would add value to the consortium
- INCO partners as associated partners
